PRIMARY TEXT:

Matthew 21, John 13:1-17

OBSERVATION AND APPLICATIONS

- Read Matthew 21:1-11 together and share what words, phrases, or moments capture your attention or raise questions for you.

- What do the crowds shouting “Hosanna!” in Matthew 21 tell us about what they expected from Jesus?

- Read John 13:1-17 together and, like question 1, share what words, phrases, or moments capture your attention or raise questions for you.

- Why is it significant that Jesus, knowing “that the Father had put all things under his power” (John 13:3), chose to wash His disciples’ feet?



SCRIPTURE

Write which passage of scripture you are reading.

OBSERVATION

What is this text saying? What is the context? How does it fit with the verses before and after it? Are there any commands or instructions?

APPLICATION

How can you apply this verse to your life? What does this mean today? What is God saying to you?

PRAYER

Respond to the passage in prayer. Ask God to help you apply this truth to your life and spend some time listening to what He may be telling you.
